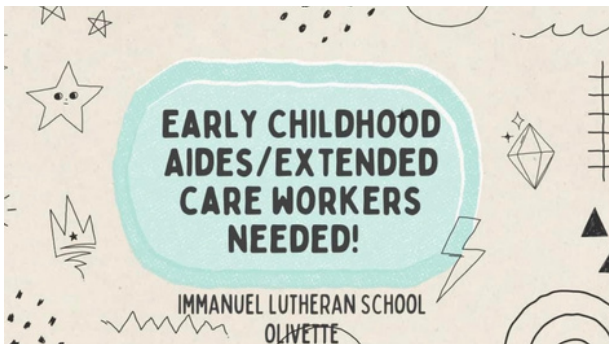

KidSight Vision Screening

Our Vision Screening Detects:


- Nearsightedness – cannot see far away
- Farsightedness – cannot see close up
- Astigmatism – cannot see far away or close up
- Amblyopia – “lazy eye”
- Anisometropia – one eye sees clearly and one is blurred
- Anisocoria – pupils are unequal
- Misalignment – eye turning in or out

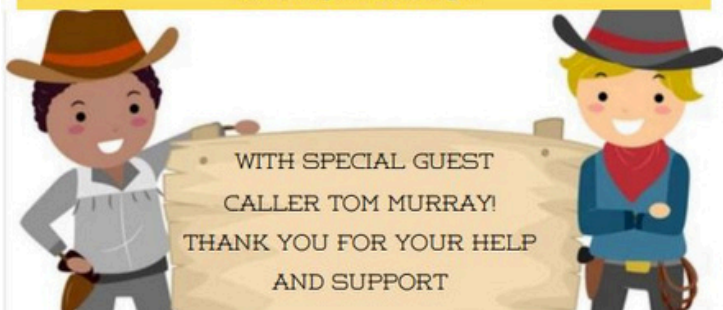

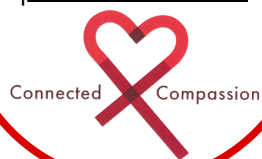
